**Elementary School Options**

**Virtual education**

Taught by your teacher(s).

*Would transition to Hybrid when possible.*

Virtual education is *synchronous* and *asynchronous*  
*Synchronous*: Students learn together through live instruction.

*Asynchronous*: Students watch recorded lessons and learn at their own pace.

**Online instruction with SchoolsPLP**

Supported by an OTSD teacher.

Online instruction is all *asynchronous*.

Requires a commitment for the full school year.

**Typical Day:**

Synchronous live instruction for 4 hours a day: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday.

Lessons will be recorded and housed in Google Classroom for students to view at their convenience.

**Same:**

- Daily Attendance and Participation
- Traditional OTSD Report Card at semester and end of the year
- Taught by OTSD Teacher
- PE and Music classes taught by OTSD staff members 4 days a week
- Special Education services will be provided by OTSD
- Access to school counselor or social worker
- Paper packets available if needed
- Chromebook and/or WiFi hotspot available for checkout if needed
- Teacher office hours available each day

**Different:**

- Online platform will be Google Classroom
- Students may work in both live and recorded sessions.
- Curriculum provided by OTSD teachers using district materials and supplemental items
- Students receive reading, writing, math instruction with social studies and science integrated into both reading and writing
- Classroom teacher provides synchronous instruction (live) for four hours a day. Student may access recorded lessons anytime.

**Typical Day:**

Log in each day and work through the SchoolsPLP website and platform with one lesson in each subject area each day.

**Same:**

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- Paper packets available if needed
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**Different:**

- SchoolsPLP accounts created for students to use the SchoolsPLP platform
- Curriculum provided through SchoolsPLP
- Students receive reading, math, social studies, and science classes
- Students work at their own pace, approximately one lesson a day in each subject area. Each lesson is about 50 minutes.
- Below grade level instruction and support, or grade level extension, provided through SchoolsPLP platform
