

Frequently Asked Questions

Summer Academy, 2021

Session 2

1. **Who is eligible to enroll in Summer Academy?**

- Elementary Academy: Any currently enrolled OTSD Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th grader.
 - Incoming Kindergarten students are not eligible.
- Middle School Academy: Any currently enrolled OTSD 5th, 6th, or 7th grader.
- Sandy High Academy: Any currently enrolled 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grader.

2. **What's the cost?**

3. **Where will the Academy's be located?**

- *Elementary Academy*: Naas Elementary
- *Middle School Academy*: Boring Middle School (session 1) and Cedar Ridge Middle School (session 2)
- *Sandy High Academy*: Sandy High School

4. **What's the schedule?**

- *Elementary Academy*

Session 2: August 2-5, August 9-12, & 16-19

Time: 9 am - 1 pm

- *Middle and High School Academies*

Session 2: August 2-5, August 9-12

Time: AM Sessions: 8 am - 11 am

PM Sessions: 11:30 am - 2:30 pm

5. **Will meals be provided?**

- Elementary students will be provided on-site breakfast and lunch.
- Middle and high students will be provided a grab & go lunch at the end of the morning session/beginning of afternoon session. Students staying for both am and pm sessions will be able to eat lunch on campus.

6. **Will transportation be provided?**

Transportation will be provided within OTSD boundaries. A schedule of routes/times will be available after registration closes.

7. What about health protocols?

Masks

We will support personal choice regarding face coverings:

- While we *recommend* face coverings for all *unvaccinated* students and adults, face coverings will be *optional*
- *Please note:* Face coverings are currently *required on school buses*, as mandated by the CDC

General Protocols

We will continue to implement our established protocols for the following, as recommended by ODE/OHA:

- School cleaning and disinfecting
- Hand washing and sanitizing
- Student cohorts and 3-feet physical distancing, to the extent possible
- Isolation and quarantine, when necessary

8. Do I have to attend both sessions?

- Elementary students may attend Session 1 or Session 2 or both sessions.
- Middle and high school students may attend an AM class and/or a PM class and they may also choose to attend Session 1 and/or Session 2.

9. What if my child can't make every day of the session?

- Attendance is not required at the elementary sessions, but it will be at the secondary-level because students will be working toward earning credits.
- We do expect students to participate during each week of their session. We cannot accept registrations for 1-week segments of a session.

10. Will Chromebooks be used?

There will be minimal online activity depending on the class.

11. How will we be contacted with confirmation of enrollment & additional information?

- You will receive an email confirmation with your child's schedule.
- If you plan to use school bus transportation, STA will email you the bus route and schedule.

12. Will students be able to play outside on the playground?

13. What kind of activities will students get to do?

- Elementary: literacy, math, in-school science field trips, art, other enrichment
- Middle & High: academics and electives courses

14. Will there be a remote option?

There is no remote option. All classes and activities will be in-person.

15. Are homeschooled students eligible to enroll in Summer Academy?

Yes. You would need to enroll your student in OTSD for the summer; then un-enroll them in the fall if you choose to continue homeschooling.
