Oregon Trail School District: Meal Pack Breakfast and Lunch for students

- Beginning September 15, meal packs will be available to all students and served on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- A meal pack will consist of a breakfast and a lunch each for multiple days (two days of meals on Tuesday and 3 days of meals on Thursday.) Only meal packs will be served.
- There is no fee to any student for meals served through December 31, 2020 under special US Department of Agriculture funding.
- Meals may be picked up by a parent or guardian without the student(s) present.
- Meals are delivered to your vehicles, curbside, at schools or walk up at select other sites as follows:

When requesting help with childcare, you will need the following information ready:

- Parent first and last name
- Child's first name and date of birth
- Email address
- Address to search for care near your home or work
- Childcare request and days/times needed

Health care through the Oregon Health Plan:

If your income has changed, you may be eligible for OHP

The Oregon Health Plan is free health coverage for those who qualify. If your income has changed recently, you may be eligible. You can get OHP even if you have been denied in the past.
