District Issued Hotspots

Oregon Trail Families,

Hotspot requests nearly doubled from last spring. While we have over 550 units prepared for distribution, there are currently not enough hotspots in the district to provide for all who have requested a device. However, additional hotspots are on order and we are committed to acquiring quantities sufficient to provide one per family.

If your family needs a hotspot and has not yet requested one here is the process:

- If you have already completed online registration Via ParentVUE and did not request a hotspot in that process, please contact your school Secretary/Registrar. They can make that change to your registration. This will add your name to the distribution list.
- If you have not yet completed online registration via ParentVUE, you can make the hotspot request as part of that process.

We will be distributing hotspots based on the timing of requests. We will complete distribution for each of the following groups before moving on to the next group:

Requests made previous to August 31st

Requests made from September 1st - September 14th

Requests made after September 14th

Families will be informed via a ParentSquare message when a hotspot is available and how / when to pick it up.
